Mass grave Branjevo

The Branjevo Farm grave was excavated in 1996 by PHR under the auspices of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (ICTY). In 2012 an assessment by ICMP suggested more remains might be found. The excavation undertaken by PHR in 1996 was re-excavated in 2013. The area of excavation included the surroundings of the grave and an area to the southeast. The Branjevo Farm grave is associated with secondary gravesites Cancari 5, Cancari 6, Cancari 9, and Cancari 12.
