## Mass grave Crni Vrh

Between 28 July and 6 October 2003, the Tuzla Cantonal Investigative Judge, the Federation Commission on Missing Persons and ICMP undertook the excavation of a large and complicated mass grave located near the peak of a large hill called Crni Vrh situated between the villages of Ljeskovice and Planince in Eastern Bosnia close to the town of Zvornik in BiH. Site Crni Vrh, Municipality Zvornik is located some 400 meters from the main Tuzla-Zvornik road. Tuzla is 42 kilometers from the site.

The total number of complete bodies is 481, along with 148 body parts, 207 general body parts, and 128 artifacts.
